**AUSTIN --** The second annual Texas Community Music Festival will be held April 28 - May 3, 2007 in Austin, and will once again feature performances by a variety of musical groups, ranging in size from quartets to ensembles of 50 pieces or more.

In 2006, approximately 10,000 music lovers enjoyed the spectacular Austin spring weather and two weekends of music and dance performance at HEB Central Market North, where they listened, sang along and danced to a musical mix as eclectic as Austin itself.

The 2007 TCMF promises to continue the tradition, as performances will run on four consecutive nights: Saturday and Sunday, April 28-29, at HEB Central Market North, and Monday, Tuesday and Thursday, April 30, May 1 and May 3 at historic Scholz Garten, Texas' oldest restaurant and biergarten.



The 2007 TCMF performances at HEB Central Market are promoted in conjunction with "Thrill of the Grill," Central Market's annual grilling festival, which features grilling demonstrations, tips and recipes ... and the delicious result of those demonstrations. The festival is hosted by the Austin Civic Wind Ensemble, Austin's oldest community band.

The Scholz Garten portion of the program will feature Texas polka, brass and jazz bands, and will be a kind of "South by SouthWURST" in honor of the European tradition of the venue and the music of most of the performers.

The 2007 Festival culminates Thursday, May 3, with a performance at Scholz Garten by the Wurst Band, an Austin institution for more than 30 years. The curtain will come down in the TCMF to the traditional "*In Heaven There Is No Beer.*"
